A law enforcement dispatcher plays a vital and key role in the apprehension and prosecution of a domestic violence suspect. A woman is physically abused by her husband every 9 seconds in the United States. A call taker and dispatcher must know the variety of ways that calls of family and domestic violence may be referred to a dispatch center. 35% of emergency-room visits by women are for symptoms that may be the result of spousal abuse, as few as 5% of these victims are ever categorized
