2010 Great Texas Warrant Round-up



Alvin, Texas – The City of Alvin Police Department and the City of Alvin Municipal Court are joining forces with more than 265 agencies state wide for the 2010 Great Texas Warrant Round-up. The Round-up begins Saturday, March 6, 2010. Alvin PD will be working with nearly 70 agencies in the greater Houston-Galveston area in this annual effort targeting people who have outstanding warrants in their respective jurisdictions.

The City of Alvin Municipal Court has more than 1,400 active warrants it is seeking to clear. The Court and the Police Department encourage anyone with warrants to take the time between now and March 6th to clear their outstanding warrants. No amnesty is being offered during this event.

When the Round-up begins, officers will be actively seeking and arresting those persons whose warrants have not been cleared up. Warrants are valid across the entire state and subject the wanted person to arrest at any location, including their home, work and school.
