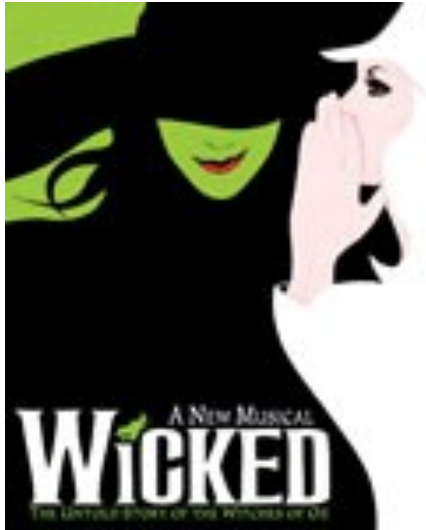


## Luau !

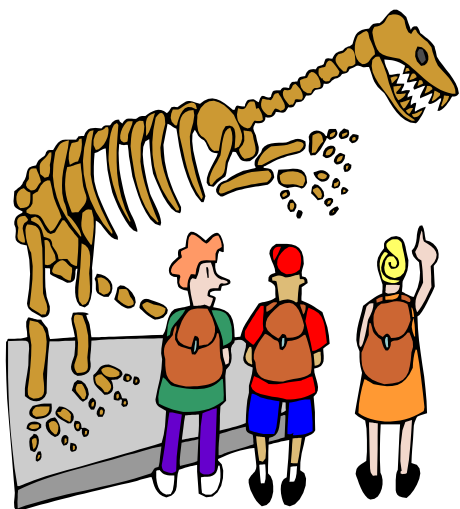
## Theater District Day –Houston
