Fire Fighter/Paramedic (Full-time)

Job Description

Provide emergency medical care at MICU level, such as cardiac monitoring and defibrillation, intravenous and drug therapy and airway management with endotracheal intubations. Firefighter Paramedics will work under general supervision of a superior officer, but are expected to coordinate patient care at medical response scenes. Firefighter Paramedics must be able to respond to emergency calls for fire suppression and rescues activities. Assist with minor repairs and maintenance on facilities, apparatus and equipment.

Minimum Requirements

Applicants must have a current State of Texas DL, be certified or certifiable as a Firefighter through the Texas Commission on Fire Protection, and an EMT-Paramedic through the Texas Department of State Health Services. If you are a Certified Paramedic and currently enrolled in a Fire Academy you may be considered.

Pay and Benefits

Starting salary \$35,000 to \$38,000 per year depending on certifications. There are three rotating 24 hour shifts based on an average 53 hour work week plus other full-time employee benefits. Full-time Employee benefits include: Health Insurance (100% paid by City for employee, 75% paid for Family) Medical Benefits Plans, includes Dental and Vision; Paid Vacation, Sick Time, Paid Holidays; 457 Deferred Compensation Plan (Participation Voluntary); TMRS, Contribution Rate of 7% matching 2 to 1; Section 125 Cafeteria Plan; Supplemental Insurance Plan; Employee Assistance Program; Long Term Disability (Provided by City); Accidental Death and Dismemberment (Provided by City); Group Life (Provided by City); Voluntary Term Life Insurance Program; Direct Deposit; Longevity Pay; Certification and Education Pay as applicable.
